GUIDELINES FOR COMMITMENT TO MEDINA COUNTY JAIL

When committing yourself to Medina County Jail, enter the reception area of the Sheriff's Office and sign the visitation log. Any sentence that is 72 hours or less, will be served to the minute. Any sentence longer than 72 hours will be counted by day. To receive credit for your first day, you must report to the jail before 4pm on that day. Everyone who reports for jail time is subject to search by an officer, body scan, and mandatory drug test.

APPROVED ITEMS

Anyone who commits themselves will be able to bring in 3 white T-shirts (with sleeves and absent from any writing, no tank tops), 3 pairs of all white underwear, 3 pairs of all white socks and one rubber band style hair tie. Woman can bring in one solid white bra that has no underwire or padding. Do not bring in any excessive items such as bags or books. All cash that is brought in will be placed directly into the inmate's account after the booking process is completed. You may bring in prescription medications if they are in the original bottle with your prescription label. **All prescriptions are verified and approved by the jail physician prior to being dispensed.** Glasses or contacts (sealed in original case) are also permitted.

BOOKS

Books may be purchased for inmates off any retailer website if the book is new, sold, and shipped directly by the distributor.

VISITATIONS

Inmates have access to visitation after they have completed the inmate orientation period. Each housing unit has different times and days. It is the responsibility of each inmate to sign up their visitors and alert them to the assigned time. Video visitation is available through the link on our website.

VEHICLES

You are not permitted to leave your vehicle in the parking lot for the duration of your stay. Any vehicles left overnight will be subject to towing.
